

2025 JUBILEE – "PILGRIMS OF HOPE"

In the words of Pope Francis: "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us, and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision."

Pope Francis will open the Jubilee Year on December 24th, with the official opening of the Holy door of Saint Peter's Basilica and continuing until January 6, 2026, the Solemnity of the Epiphany, with the closing of the Holy Door. In the Archdiocese of Toronto, Cardinal Leo invites us to participate in the Jubilee Year with a Solemn Opening Mass taking place on Sunday, December 29th, at 5:00 pm at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica. **On this weekend, we will introduce the Jubilee Prayer which will be prayed after Communion at all Masses throughout the Jubilee year.**
