Saint Rita of Cascia - an Italian widow and an Augustinian Nun who lived from 1381 to 1457. She is known as the Patroness of Impossible Causes and became a nun at age 36 after the death of her husband and her twin sons. At about sixty years of age, she was meditating before an image of Christ crucified when suddenly a small wound appeared on her forehead, as though a thorn from the crown that encircled Christ's head had penetrated her own flesh. Up until her death Rita bore this external sign of stigmatisation and union with the Lord. At her canonization ceremony, she was bestowed the title of Patroness for impossible causes. whereas in many Catholic countries. Rita came to be known to be the Patroness of heartbroken women. specifically for sterility, abuse victims, loneliness, marriage difficulties, parenthood, widows, and bodily ills. St. Rita – pray for us.
