## NARTHEX ADDITION UPDATE



As of this week, the 'Bell Tower' has been erected - we are awaiting for the inscription of the 'cast bronze bell' to be delivered. The electrical wiring has been approved by the Inspector, and we are hopeful that this week, the drywallers will commence their work. As mentioned in last weeks' announcement by the Finance Committee, we received approval from the Archdiocese for a loan to help finance the completion of the construction. The loan amount is \$917,00.00 with an annual interest rate of 2.5% payable on or before 15 years. The monthly repayments will be approximately \$5,000.00 per month and will begin in July/August.
