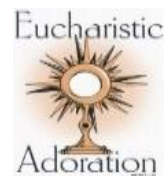

## “NARTHEX ADDITION” COMPLETION COUNTDOWN

We are approaching completion in the next couple of weeks. Finishing touches are taking place before the final inspection is made to obtain the occupancy permit from the Township. The stained glass windows on the west façade of the curtain wall will be installed (the remaining south & north side will be installed in the new year), the statues will have their permanent place, we have ordered the “Giving Tree” for the donor’s wall and a collage of Augustinian Priests who have served our Sacred Heart Parish since 1960. It is our hope to have these items in place before the grand opening.
