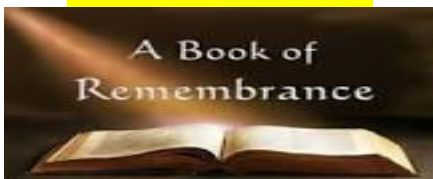
HOLY NAME SCHOOL CELEBRATION OF HOLY MASS 9:30 AM IN THE SCHOOL GYMNASIUM
