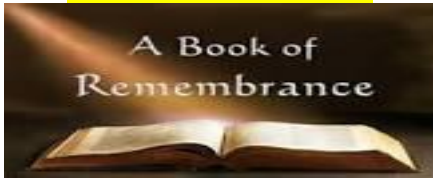
Silent Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament begins at 3:30 pm, Benediction at 6:45 followed by Holy Mass at 7:00 pm.
