## The Feast of The Epiphany of Our Lord

**Epiphany** - the day which the three wise men from the east visited Bethlehem and offered gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh to Jesus and his family. The word "epiphany" comes from the Greek *epiphainen*, which means "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known." The feast of the Epiphany celebrates the many ways that Christ has made Himself known to the world. The feast unites three events in the life of Jesus when His divinity, shines through His humanity; the adoration of the Magi; the Baptism of the Christ in the Jordan; and the first miracle at the wedding feast of Cana.

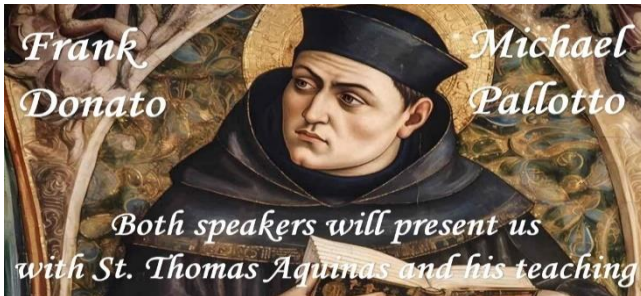
