

**WORLD MARRIAGE DAY –** The day for celebrating Holy Matrimony and its commitment to one another.





During this Lenten Season, the Stations of the Cross will be prayed every Friday evening beginning at 6:15 pm, followed by Holy Mass at 7:00 pm.


