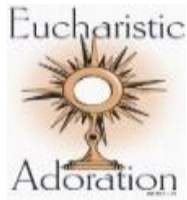

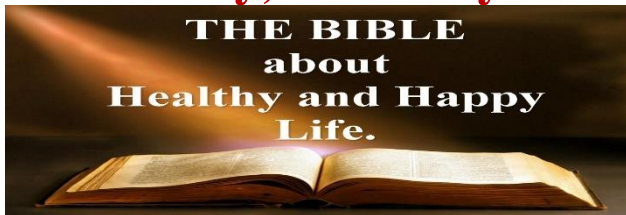
The Stations of the Cross
