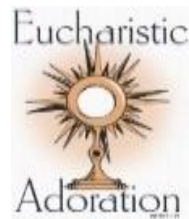

SECOND SCRUTINY (RCIA)

During the 8:30 am Mass
this Sunday, March 10TH

We are invited to pray for our Elect in a special way. Scrutiny are prayers for healing, for liberation, and for forgiveness which all of us offer on behalf of the elect. In these rites, we ask God to assist our RCIA candidates embrace the love of God; giving them strength against the power of sin. In the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, the season of Lent takes on special importance. Those adults who are asking to share in the life of our risen Savior through the sacrament of baptism have entered the final stage of preparation. And so it is for the elect of our parish.
