THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION (RCIA)

**DURING THE 8:30 AM MASS THIS WEEKEND
FEBRUARY 28TH**

For the last several weeks, our Catechumens, **JOCEY RICARDO PEREZ SANCHEZ AND MABEL TEJEDA GONZALEZ**, have explored their own faith and journey and whether the Catholic Church is the place to continue that journey. They have prayed about it and have decided to take the next step. They will publicly for the first time declare their intentions to the Church, and the Church, in turn, accepts them as persons who intended to become its members. We, the parish, as the Church, have a part in this Rite. We are asked to warmly welcome them into our Catholic faith family and to support them with our prayers. The second of the three stages of the process is the Rite of Election or Enrollment, the ritual during which the elected names are placed in a "Book of the Elect" as a sign of their willingness to prepare themselves for full incorporation into the Church. The Scrutiny's will be held on Sunday, March 7th, 8:30 am; Sunday, March 14th, 8:30 am; and Sunday, March 21st, 8:30 am.
