UPDATE ON RE-OPENING FOR PLACES OF WORSHIP

This past week, the Province of Ontario announced their reopening plan and revisions to the “Roadmap for Reopening” as they relate to places of worship. STEP 1 - begins on Friday, June 11th, churches will be opening at 15% capacity (on a first come basis) STEP 2 – may begin on July 2nd, the capacity will be 25% (on a first come basis).

GUIDELINES FOR RETURNING TO CHURCH

Before coming to church, please check your temperature of all family members and remain home if you are experiencing any symptoms or if you are feeling anxious. Upon arriving to the church, maintain physical distancing at all times, in the parking lot and church entrance. Sanitize your hands upon entry (there are 2 stands on each side). Pew and aisles are clearly marked to note physical distancing. Families and household living at the same residence may sit together.

GUIDELINES FOR CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARIST

We ask that you do not hold hands or shake hands during any portion of the celebration of the Eucharist. At the Sign of Peace, a nod or bow to others is appropriate. There will be NO offertory procession or collection. Please leave your donation in the designated basket upon entry/departure. At the time of Communion, kindly follow direction of the Usher maintaining your distance. Holy Communion is received in the hand only, place one hand on top of the other, allowing the Priest to safely place the Body of Christ in one’s hand without contact.
