We are discovering that many house cleaning products have negative effects on long-term health and the environment. **Eco-friendly cleaning solutions** reduces risk of irritation to eyes, skin and respiratory; is free of toxins and hazardous materials; and have no harmful fumes. - 4 tablespoons baking soda and 1 quart of water. Use for Kitchen appliances and bathroom fixtures.
