As part of the ongoing generosity of our parishioners, I am keeping you informed of the following work that has been done this week: The nosing around the newly installed floor has been varnished. Our thanks to Mike & Mary Fiume. The "canopy" on top of the Risen Christ was removed and LED lighting was replaced, the Stations of the Cross on both sides of the Sanctuary were moved closer to the existing ones. The wood statues of St. Joseph and Mother Mary were moved to the back wall. Our thanks to Mario Aquino, (Aquicon Construction). The words "He is Risen" will be placed on top of the mosaic so that both sides are identical in size.
