### REUSABLE MASKS

Due to Covid-19, we have been sending a lot of single use items to landfill. A way to reduce waste is to wear reusable, washable masks. According to Dr. Tam, Canada’s Medical Officer of Health; Fabric masks should be made of at least 3 layers; include 2 layers of a tightly woven fabric, such as cotton or linen; include a third (middle) layer such as non-woven polypropylene fabric, which is washable or a disposable filter, such as a folded paper towel. If possible, use a mask that is made up of different fabrics for the inside and the outside so that you know which side is close to your mouth.

## A SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING CAPACITY LIMIT

We want to thank you for your ongoing support during this period of great uncertainty. We are especially grateful to the volunteers who have helped ensure our church is a safe place to gather – they have done incredible work! As you know, the number of new COVID-19 cases in York Region have increased significantly in recent days and we are now in a ‘RED ZONE’ as identified by the Province of Ontario. Local medical officers of health have also made strong recommendations for places of worship to reduce their capacity in order to minimize potential transmission. To protect our community and out of love for our neighbour, Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto, has made the difficult decision that we must temporarily further restrict attendance at our liturgical celebrations. As of Tuesday, November 24<sup>th</sup>, attendance at all liturgical celebrations will be limited to 50 worshippers in the entire building at one time. These DO NOT include clergy and volunteers who are involved in ministry during the Mass. Those of you who are unable to join us in person, we will continue to livestream on FACEBOOK LIVE during the 10:00 am Mass and Wednesday evening Masses. The Daily mass is also televised on Salt+Light TV, EWTN and Vision TV among other locations. We are grateful to all the parishioners who support the ongoing operation and maintenance costs of our parish.
