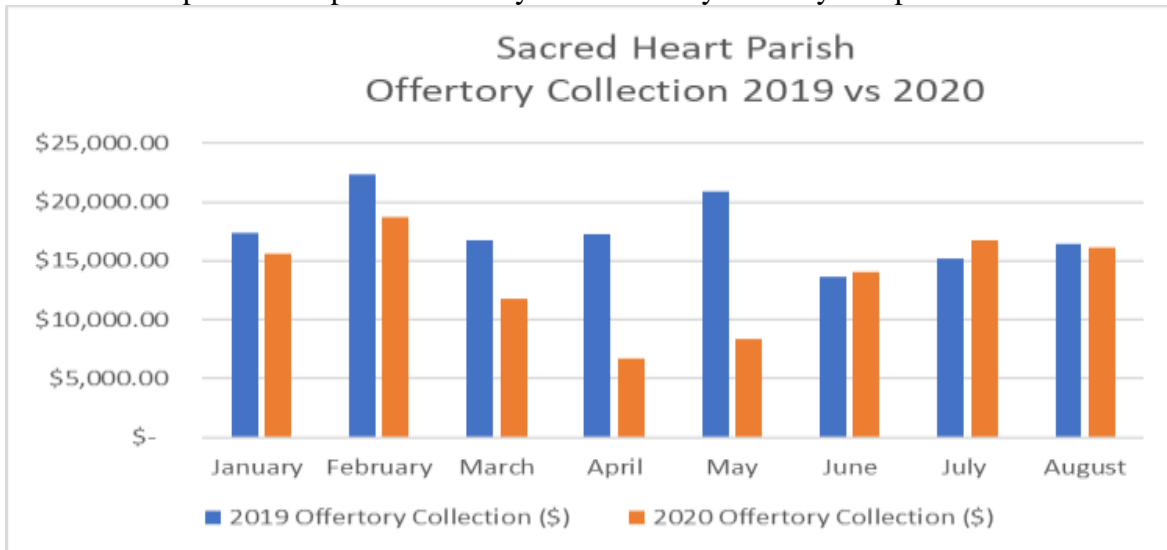

We now live in a strange new world. Things we took for granted – eating out, doctor’s appointments, getting together with family and friends, etc. – all take more planning and care (assuming we can do them at all). For three long months this year, we could not celebrate the Eucharist as a community – including Easter, the most holy Christian celebration. We thank you very much for your continued financial support during this COVID-19 pandemic. The graph below shows the impact on the parish offertory collections by monthly comparison of 2019 versus 2020.



The parish has been able to realize some of the following cost savings on the ongoing operational and maintenance costs during the COVID-19 pandemic:

- Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) in the amount of \$21,600.
- Church, Hall, and Rectory cleaning cost reduction in the amount of \$18,826.
- Groundskeeping cost reduction in the amount of \$9,103.

We are grateful to all the parish volunteers who have made the continued operation of our parish possible.

A method to ensure consistent operating revenues is the use of Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG), whereby parishioners can register for a pre-authorized monthly donation in-lieu of using the weekly donation envelopes. PAG donation amounts are included in your annual donation tax receipt. This will allow for consistent monthly offertory revenues throughout the year. Please consider signing up for PAG.
