FAMILY OF FAITH

This year Sacred Heart Parish has made it a core priority to actively raise the funds for the Narthex expansion project. Upon review of our financial statements, it was noted that the Parish has a total of \$98,110. of funds remaining from the Family of Faith campaign that can be utilized towards the Narthex project. Since April 2020, all initial Family of Faith campaign commitments have been fully satisfied, where possible, including the fifth commitment added in 2020 to urgently repair leaks within our church roof. The application of these funds will help cover various Phase 2 building costs, such as steel, mechanical and electrical expenses, and help the parish progress forward in our fundraising goal. The Parish is currently seeking approval from the Archdiocese to apply the remaining Family of Faith funds towards the Narthex project.
