FAST AND ABSTINENCE ON

UPCOMING HOLY DAYS

The Church suggests fasting (only one full meal and two smaller meals which together are not greater than a full meal) and abstinence from meat of Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics aged 18 – 59 are bound to fast; those 14 – 59 to abstinence. Those who are ill are freed from these obligations. Everyone, even those above the age of 59, are encouraged to fast and abstain. All Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety in place of abstinence. Parents and educators are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance.

Announcement of Bishop Francis (Frank) Leo as New Archbishop of Toronto

Pope Francis has appointed Bishop Francis (Frank) Leo, currently Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Montreal, as the 14th Archbishop of Toronto. The archbishop-designate succeeds Cardinal Thomas Collins, who has served the archdiocese since 2007. The new archbishop will be installed at a ceremony at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica on Saturday, March 25th on the Solemnity of the Annunciation. During this time of transition in the archdiocese, we give thanks for Cardinal Collins and his service to the Church and welcome Archbishop-designate Leo, who will be joining the community very soon. Please continue to keep these shepherds close in prayer in the days ahead.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA PROGRAM)

For the last several weeks, our Catechumens, **MYLES TYLER SCOTT ANEVICH; MICHEL BENJAMIN HENZE; EHIMWENMA OMOLABAKE OSIFO OFUNIM; JEREMIAS CANO RAYMUNDO;** and **JONA JAVIER SANTOS**, have explored their own faith and journey and whether the Catholic Church is the place to continue that journey. They have prayed about it and have decided to take the next step. They will publicly for the first time declare their intentions to the Church, and the Church, in turn, accepts them as persons who intended to become its members. We are asked to warmly welcome them into our Catholic faith family and to support them with our prayers. The second of the three stages of the process is the **Rite of Election** or Enrollment, the ritual during which the elected names are placed in a "Book of the Elect" as a sign of their willingness to prepare themselves for full incorporation into the Church. This Ceremony will take place next **Sunday, February 26th at St. Clare of Assisi Church, Woodbridge at 3:00 pm.** We ask you to pray for these Candidates as they deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ during this time of discernment.
