Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion

For the last several weeks, our Catechumens, David Robert John Edwards: Mateo Morales Edwards: **Armando Morales Edwards:** Isabela Morales Edwards; Yaneidys Morales Miranda; Jeremy John Paulus; Rochelle Coombs-Paulus; Arek Elden Paulus; Tymon Adler Paulus, have explored their own faith and journey and whether the Catholic Church is the place to continue that journey. They have prayed about it and have decided to take the next step. They will publicly for the first time declare their intentions to the Church, and the Church, in turn, accepts them as persons who intended to become its members. We, the parish, as the Church, have a part in this Rite. We are asked to warmly welcome them into our Catholic faith family and to support them with our prayers.
