NARTHEX UPDATE

(THE NEW ENTRANCE TO OUR CHURCH)

COST OF THE 'NEW NARTHEX'

The new cost is **\$1.9 M**

Money we have already received
and commitments from various trades
to-date **\$1.4M**

**Our Fundraising request is
\$500,000.00**

**Note: The Archdiocese permission to
proceed, will be granted once we have
collected all the funds.**

Why has the projected cost of the 'new
Narthex' increased?

1. **Inflation** factor (well publicized in the media)
2. **New** 30,000 gallon 'underground water cistern' for fire protection
3. **'Stair and ramp'** in the Narthex entrance required for safe accessibility without significant change

OUR CURRENT POSITION TO-DATE:

- We have a draft Site Plan Agreement from King Township which is being circulated to the Archdiocese of Toronto for execution
- We are diligently working with King Township for a building permit anticipated in the next few weeks
- We have received a 'cost summary' from a General Contractor
- **Construction start targeted for end of March – early April**

To help with our ongoing fundraising efforts, beginning next week-end, March 13th, and going forward, every second weekend of the Month, there will be a 'Second Collection' exclusively for the Narthex Project.
