MARY, THE HOLY MOTHER OF GOD

Today we celebrate the Motherhood of Mary, an aspect of the life of Our Lady that many of us can relate to. In today's Gospel, shepherds visit Mary, Joseph, and Jesus and reveal to them that Jesus is the Messiah. Mary ponders this. She can do this because she trusts God and gives him his rightful place – as the one in control of the future. Contemplating the future can be scary. God has a plan for each of us, but he unfolds it little by little. None of us know the full picture or implications.
