The Site Plan Agreement has been executed and Building Permit is ready to be released by King Township once the appropriate Construction Fencing has been installed.


The construction contract with Aquicon Construction has been completed and Aquicon will be mobilizing on site early August, to erect the appropriate construction fencing and commence construction.
