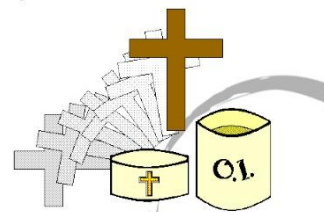
## Anointing of the Sick

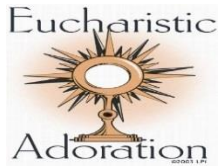

Money we have already received and commitments from various trades to-date is **\$1.4M**

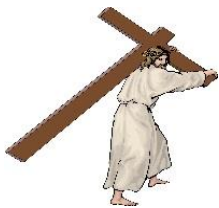
