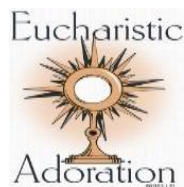
Join us in praying the Novena **every Wednesday**

## FEAST DAY OF ST. RITA OF CASCIA THURSDAY, MAY 22ND

Join us for Holy Rosary at 6:00 pm followed  
by Holy Mass at 7:00 pm - blessing of Holy  
Oils and sharing of light refreshments in  
the Hall afterwards. Saint Rita of Cascia -  
an Italian widow and an Augustinian Nun  
who lived from 1381 to 1457. She is known  
as the Patroness of Impossible Causes and  
became a nun at age 36 after the death  
of her husband and her twin sons. Up until  
her death Rita bore this external sign of  
stigmatisation and union with the Lord. At  
her canonization ceremony, she was  
bestowed the title of Patroness for  
impossible causes, whereas in many  
Catholic countries, Rita came to be  
known to be the Patroness of heartbroken  
women, specifically for sterility, abuse  
victims, loneliness, marriage difficulties,  
parenthood, widows, and bodily ills.
