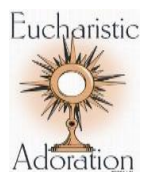

CARDINAL LEO APPOINTED AS MEMBER OF THE VATICAN'S DICASTERY FOR EVANGELIZATION

On June 30, 2026, the Holy See announced that
Pope Leo XIV has appointed Frank Cardinal Leo,
Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto, as a member
of the Vatican's Dicastery for Evangelization.

Churches."*

HUMANITARIAN RELIEF VENEZUELA EARTHQUAKE

A devastating series of earthquakes struck north-central Venezuela on June 24, 2026, making it the country's largest seismic disaster in more than a century. Two powerful earthquakes—a magnitude of 7.2 followed just 39 seconds later with a magnitude of 7.5 near Yumare/San Felipe in Yaracuy State, caused catastrophic damage across much of the country. The hardest-hit areas include Caracas, La Guaira, and surrounding coastal regions, where buildings collapsed, roads and bridges were damaged, and power and communications have been disrupted. Authorities declared a national state of emergency, while teams from Venezuela and numerous international partners continue to search for survivors. As of June 29, official reports indicate more than 1,400 people have died, 3,000 people have been injured, thousands are reported missing and tens of thousands of families have been left homeless. The Archdiocese of Toronto will accept donations and channel funds through our Catholic partners in South America to support relief efforts underway.
