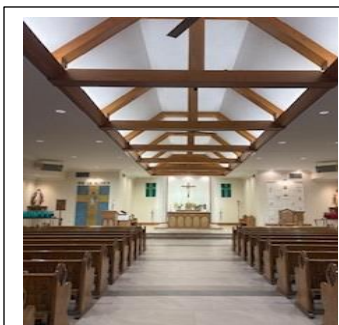


GALA & RAFFLE TICKET SALES
