SIXTH WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

The theme chosen by Pope Leo XIV for the 6th World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly - **'I will never forget you'** (Is 49:15) reminds us that God's unwavering love is the ultimate answer to the isolation and neglect so often experienced by the elderly. It brings comfort and hope, assuring us that the Lord knows each of us personally forgets no one, and loves us unconditionally, even though the frailties of old age. Since its creation in 2021, the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly has grown into a cherished tradition that teaches our communities to truly value the elderly, not through occasional gestures, but as a permanent, central part of our lives. This celebration helps us appreciate older generations as vital keepers of our history, witnesses to our faith, and teachers of our lives. This year, we want to place a special emphasis on closeness to others. We ask you to reach out directly to those who live alone, are staying in care homes, or have no visitors. Let this day be a tangible opportunity for everyone – especially the young people – to spend time with their grandparents, the elderly in their families, and most importantly, those who are lonely and completely isolated.

united in You.

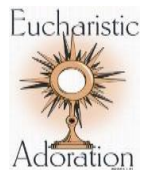
