Facts about St. Peter the Apostle

"You are Peter, and on this rock, I will build my Church"
St. Peter was the first Pope and Vicar of Christ. A Fisherman turned shepherd of souls. St. Peter struggled with doubt and human weaknesses, but Jesus chose him anyway. St. Peter led the early Church with bold faith, entrusted by Christ with the keys of Heaven, he laid the foundation of the papacy through sacrifice and love. He is the Patron Saint of Popes and fishermen.

Facts about St. Paul the Apostle

St. Paul experienced a great conversion on the road to Damascus during the persecution of Christians. He was baptized and dedicated his life to spreading the Gospel. His letters are in the New Testament. These writings shed light on the faith of the early Church. Before he was named Paul, his name was Saul. He was a Jewish Pharisee who zealously persecuted Christians in Jerusalem. Saint Paul was imprisoned and executed under Emperor Nero. He is the Patron Saint of missionaries and evangelists.

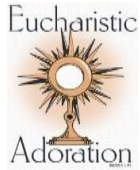
