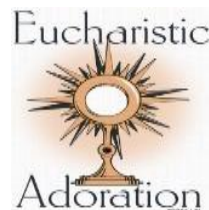

## REGISTRATION FOR SACRAMENTS IN 2026

Each year, the Church extends an invitation to children and youth to prepare for the initiation sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. An invitation is extended to children, who:

- Are Baptized
- Attend Catholic, public or private Schools
- Are Registered Parishioners of Sacred Heart
- Are in Grade 2 or older for First Holy Communion/First Reconciliation
- Are in Grade 7 or 8 for Confirmation

For both First Holy Communion and Confirmation, the **parish** is responsible for the **immediate preparation**. Since the preparation and celebration of the Sacraments is the responsibility of the Church, notices regarding registration and the process involved are provided by the church.
