
FEAST DAY OF ST. AUGUSTINE
THURSDAY, AUGUST 28TH



At the age of 31, St. Augustine converted to Christianity, after his conversion he was prompted by hearing a child's voice say, "take up and read" (Latin: *tolle lege*). St. Augustine was a theologian, writer, preacher, advocate, and bishop. Although he experienced many hardships in his life, Saint Augustine set an example for men and women around the world to follow. His work is reflected in the lives of Catholics in the Augustinian tradition who continue to care for those in great need. The rule, developed by St. Augustine, governs chastity, poverty, obedience, detachment from the world, the apportionment of labour, the inferiors, fraternal charity, prayer in common, fasting and abstinence proportionate to the strength of the individual, care of the sick, silence and reading. St. Augustine is the **Patron Saint** of brewers, printers, theologians and several cities and dioceses. St. Augustine's most often quoted phrase that captures something that resonates deep within the human person is ***"You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You."*** We pray for Pope Leo XIV, the Augustinian Religious Order all over the world and the Augustinian Fathers and Brothers who are buried in our Sacred Heart Parish Cemetery.



Saint Carlo Acutis created a website about Eucharistic miracles worldwide called "Eucharistic Miracles of the World". A daily Mass goes from the age of seven, he lived his life through profound acts of love for his neighbour, especially the disadvantaged. His motto since then was "To be close to Jesus, that is my life plan", serves to inspire many from all walks of life. He was also famous for his quotes, "The Eucharist is my highway to heaven" and "People who place themselves before the sun get a tan; people who place themselves before the Eucharist become saints".



Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati, known for his charitable outreach dedicated much of his spare time to taking care of the poor, the homeless, and the sick as well as demobilized servicemen returning from World War I. An avid mountain climber, he wrote the phrase "Verso L'Alto," which means "to the heights." This phrase has become a motto for Catholics inspired by Frassati to strive for the summit of eternal life with Christ.
