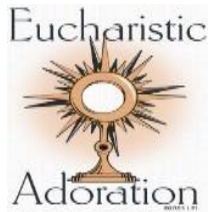

### ACTION REQUIRED

The Catholic Women's League has been asked by the National Office to act with 'petitions' to push back against two proposals that the Federal Government intends to pass. One is regarding the protection of the charitable status of pro-life and religious organizations that they wish to remove and the second is a proposal to change consent procedure for medical assistance in dying (MAID) to that of advanced requests. These are significant concerns to all Catholics.
